Our responsibilities do not extend to any other information.

Scope of the audit of the financial statements

An audit involves obtaining evidence about the amounts and disclosures in the financial statements sufficient to give reasonable assurance that the financial statements are free from material misstatement, whether caused by fraud or error. This includes an assessment of whether the accounting policies are appropriate the the friendly society's circumstances and have been consistently applied and adequately disclosed; the reasonableness of significant accounting estimates; and the overall presentation of the financial statements. In addition we read all the financial and non-financial information in the year end report to identify material inconsistencies with the audited financial statements. If we become aware of any apperent material misstatements we consider the implications for our report.

NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS For the year ended 31 December 2020

1. Accounting policies

Accounting convention

The accounts are prepared on an historical cost basis, with the exception of the re-valuation of the property. The accounts are prepared on a cash basis with the exception of the audit fee which is accrued at the year end.

Revenue recognition

Turnover is recognised when monies are received in respect of memberships and in respect of organised events.

Fixed assets

Depreciation is provided on fixed assets so as to write-off the cost of the fixed asset over it's estimated useful life at the following rates :

Regalia 7% written down value Equipment 25% written down value

Trade marks are not depreciated as it is considered that their value is at lease renewed each year.

Property is not depreciated as the company maintains the property in a state more than sufficient to maintain it's value. The cost of such repairs is passed through the income and expenditure account as incurred.
